

It's interesting to note that the Bible talks about giving in spiritual terms and, referring to it as a spiritual gift, goes on to encourage generosity (Romans 12.8). This suggests it takes God's help to be a generous giver, a divine form of gift aid if you like. We gift-aid our giving for efficiency; God gift-aids the giver for generosity [RT].
