#### LONDON TO BRIGHTON IN SUPPORT OF GLASSDOOR

Mike Burton will be cycling the 85km from London to Brighton today in aid of Glassdoor - the homeless charity that has a long link with St Barnabas.

The demands on the charity are acute with lockdown exacerbating an already difficult problem. Last year they still managed to help 1,600 people with over 400 finding work and a permanent place to live and that number is expected to rise this winter. They have noticed a sizeable rise in the number women on the streets as well as a stream of trafficked refugees being forced to pay back crossing fees so your help is needed more than ever.

So please dig deep. Mike will match all donations so any payments big or small will go a long way.

<sup>9</sup> Woe to you who strive with your Maker, earthen vessels with the potter! Does the clay say to the one who fashions it, 'What are you making?'

or 'Your work has no handles'?

<sup>10</sup> Woe to anyone who says to a father, 'What are you begetting?'

or to a woman, 'With what are you in labour?'

<sup>11</sup> Thus says the LORD,

the Holy One of Israel, and its Maker:

Will you question me about my children, or command me concerning the work of my hands?

<sup>12</sup>I made the earth, and created humankind upon it;

it was my hands that stretched out the heavens, and I commanded all their host.

<sup>13</sup>I have aroused Cyrus in righteousness, and I will make all his paths straight;

he shall build my city

and set my exiles free,

not for price or reward,

says the LORD of hosts.

14 Thus says the LORD:

The wealth of Egypt and the merchandise of Ethiopia,

and the Sabeans, tall of stature,

<sup>30</sup> They went on from there and passed through Galilee. He did not want anyone to know it; <sup>31</sup> for he was teaching his disciples, saying to them, 'The Son of Man is to be betrayed into human hands, and they will kill him, and three days after being killed, he will rise again.' 32 But they did not understand what he was saving and were afraid to ask him.

33 Then they came to Capernaum; and when he was in the house he asked them, 'What were you arguing about on the way?' 34 But they were silent, for on the way they had argued with one another about who was the greatest. <sup>35</sup> He sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, 'Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all.' <sup>36</sup> Then he took a little child and put it among them; and taking it in his arms, he said to them, <sup>37</sup> 'Whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me, and whoever welcomes me welcomes not me but the one who sent me.'
