²⁵To whom then will you compare me,
or who is my equal? says the Holy One.
²⁶Lift up your eyes on high and see:

He who brings out their host and numbers

THE GOSPEL Luke 22.24-30 (NRSVA)

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus
Christ according to Luke:

ALL: GLORY TO YOU, O LORD

²⁴A dispute also arose among them as to which
one of them was to be regarded as the
greatest. ²⁵But he said to them, 'The kings of the
Gentiles lord it over them; and those in authority
over them are called benefactors. ²⁶But not so
with you; rather the greatest among you must
become like the youngest, and the leader like
one who serves. ²⁷For who is greater, the one
who is at the table or the one who serves? Is it
not the one at the table? But I am among you as
one who serves.

²⁸'You are those who have stood by me in my
trials; ²⁹and I confer on you, just as my Father
has conferred on me, a kingdom, ³⁰so that you
may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom,
and you will sit on thrones judging the twelve
tribes of Israel.
